Key Info

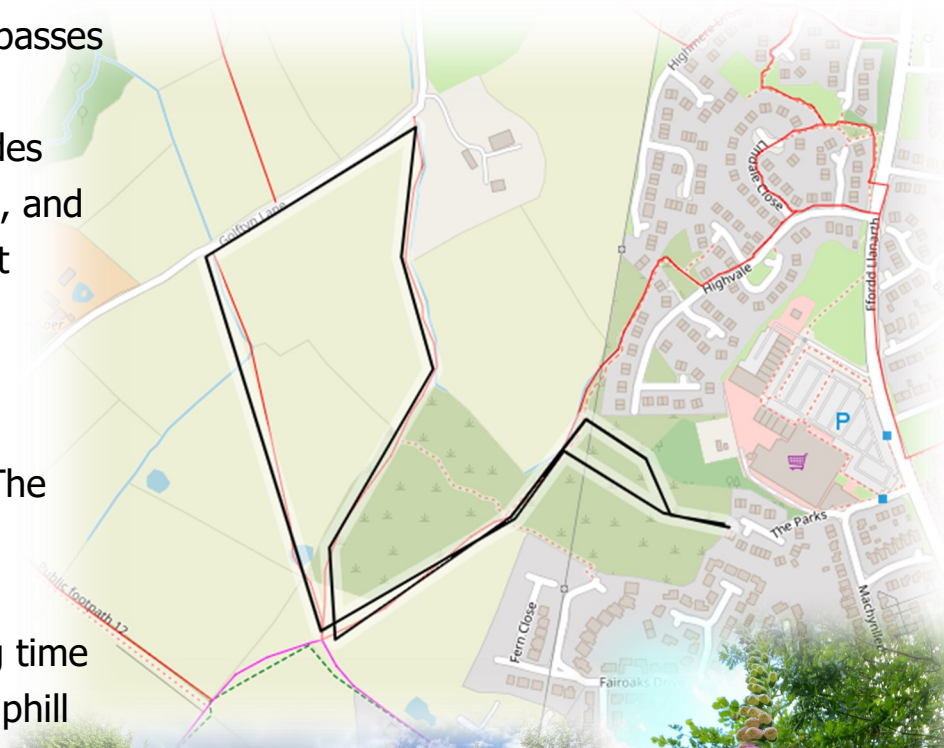
- Start (and end) point—The Parks CH54WX
- 2.19km
- Approx. 40 mins moving time
- Easy with a very short uphill section
- Some sections of path are uneven, kissing gates throughout
- Dogs on leads in some sections

Directions

1. Enter the Quay Wetlands from the Parks (CH54WX) at the end of the cul-de-sac.
2. Follow the boardwalk until you reach a fork, follow the board walk to the right.
3. Continue until you come off the board walk onto grass, keep right until you reach the next boardwalk.
4. Follow the board walk left.
5. Pass through the kissing gate until you reach another kissing gate on the left.
6. Follow the path along the field until you reach Golftyn Lane, turn left on the lane up the hill.
7. Once you reach a kissing gate on you left, go through and follow until you reach another kissing gate.
8. Once through this gate, follow the perimeter of the field (either left or right).
9. Once through another kissing gate, head down the field back towards the wetlands, you can now either take the same route back or take some time to explore the reserve.
10. Extend the walk by continuing up Golftyn Lane until you reach another public footpath on your left
